











Thrive Easter Wreath


You will need

- A4 thick paper or card
- Paper plate
- A pair of scissors
- String or ribbon
- Glue
- Sticky tape

Steps

1. Print the egg designs on to A4 thick paper or card, and cut each one out.
2. Cut out the centre of the paper plate to create a ring shape.
3. Glue each egg on to the card ring until it is covered.
4. Tape a piece of ribbon or string to the back of the ring and hang for everyone to enjoy.

Thrive Easter Decorations





Hang your decorations individually or string them together as bunting!

You will need


- A4 thick paper or card

4. When the decorations are finished, carefully cut the around the shape outline.
5. Thread string or ribbon through the holes and hang your decorations for everyone to enjoy.
